General context:

Sub-Saharan Africa is one of the richest regions in terms of renewable energy sources, but it's poor in the capability to exploit them and for this reason today just 1% of total energy consumption (oil, gas and coal account for more than 90% of energy consumption) comes from renewable energy sources. In a region where almost 600 million people lack access to energy, it's fundamental to understand how to unlock the potential of non-programmable renewable energy.

In order to help reaching the goal, RES4Africa works through three main streams: capacity building, technical assistance and organization of events.

Main tasks:

- Monitoring the socio-political, economic and energy scenario of the Sub-Saharan region: analysis of the main studies and reports;
- Supporting the execution of the RES4Africa activities in the priority countries (Ethiopia, Zambia, Kenya);
- Assisting in the preparation of events;
- Collaborating in the definition of dedicated training and capacity building programs.
